Where your donations go...

Your donations and funds raised will all go towards ensuring the people in our local communities can access the best support for their mental health. Here's what your donations can pay for...



£3 pays for a cup of coffee for a peer support session for someone going through a difficult time.



£10 pays for a voucher to go towards food parcels and meal planning for <u>Beacon Housing</u> clients.



£30 pays for a dance exercise or chair yoga session for our Leeds-based Sikh Elders Service.



£40 pays for a return taxi journey for someone in a remote rural area to get same-day mental health support with our <u>Here For You</u> service in Leeds, Kirklees, or Wakefield.



£50 pays for three staying safe kits for those who are experiencing homelessness.



£75 pays for 1-to-1 mental health support with our Wakefield Community Enablement Team for someone struggling with anxiety and depression.



£150 could fund one outreach session for our <u>Better</u> <u>Together</u> project in Burmantofts, where volunteers distribute around 60 portions of hot foods and mental health support and advice to people in need.
